

# TARPORLEY COMMUNITY CENTRE – NEW ROOF APPEAL



## What is the Problem?

- Our roof is now approaching 60 years old, has leaked at various locations in recent years
- The current roof tiles are no longer available
- Repairs are becoming increasingly difficult due to the poor condition of the roof

## How are the Trustees tackling this?

- The decision has been made to replace the whole roof (approx. 7250 tiles)
- All roofing felt & battens will be replaced
- Asbestos is present and all of this must be removed
- An architect has been appointed
- The new roof must meet CW&C and Tarporley Conservation area requirements
- The work must conform to current Health & Safety regulations

## Are there other benefits?

- Improved sound quality - acoustic tiles will be added to the ceiling of the Main Hall
- Energy saving – the thermal insulation of the roof will be greatly improved

## Who will carry out the work and what will it cost?

- Several contractors have been asked to submit bids
- Expected price over £70,000

## How are we raising funds?

- Using part of Tarporley Community Centre own reserves
- By applying for grants and donations
- Benefitting from fund-raising events such as TarpFest
- Using our Just Giving web page – search on “Tarporley Community Centre”
- Registering for Gift Aid

## When will the work be done?

- During a 6-7 week shutdown in July and August 2020

## How to donate?

- Buy a tile for £10 each
