### Funding approved for New Roof for Tarporley Community Centre



Hirers and users of Tarporley Community Centre are set to benefit from a new roof thanks to a £37,529.44 grant from FCC Communities Foundation.

The money will be used to replace the roof at the Tarporley Community Centre, High Street, Tarporley.

Anita Langford, Treasurer of Tarporley Community Centre believes the facility will make a huge difference to the lives of people living in the area.
