

FACTS YOU MAY NOT KNOW ABOUT TCC

- TCC was built in 1960's on the site of the old Victory Hall and was extended twice in 1980's.
- TCC is run by a Committee of volunteers in trust for the residents of Tarporley and neither Tarporley Parish Council or CWAC have anything to do with the running of it.
- There are no paid employees.
- TCC is a registered Charity (no 1040034) and is governed by the Charities Commission.
- TCC's Car Park is leased by CWAC to allow anyone to park there for up to 3 hours.
- Prior to 2007, the Car Park was restricted to users of TCC only.
- Tarporley Parish Council maintain the Children's Play Area which is for children under age 12 and also provide a grant towards the mowing of the field.
- The adjoining playing field at 1.1 hectare is the largest green space in Tarporley.
- Dogs are not allowed on the playing field and must be kept on a lead when being walked on the Pram Path.
- It costs approximately £3,000 per month to run TCC with the largest monthly bill being for cleaning.
- In 2016 there was an average of 120 bookings per month peaking at 140 in November 2016. November 2015 had the highest ever number at 163.
- 95% of TCCs income comes from hiring out rooms and the playing field.
- Hurricane Doris has had an impact on the roof at TCC and may have shortened its life. We will need to undertake fund raising to generate funds to replace this.
- The Main Hall floor is 'sprung' and built to the same standard as Blackpool Tower Ballroom.
